

## A Note from Rev. Phil October 2025

October 12, 2025

Dear Beloved of First United Presbyterian Church of Tarentum,

Rarely, if ever, do I write a second letter in a month. Yet today is different.

I want to imagine for a moment that I gave you \$1. Take that \$1 and put it in your wallet, shove it into your purse, put that \$1 in your pocket, or even deposit that \$1 in your bank account.

Now, three days later I want you to imagine you receive a letter that says this "On behalf of the Presbyterian Churches of Pittsburgh Presbytery (which includes First United) your \$1 you received is now \$1700." Imagine opening your wallet and instead of \$1 there is \$1700. You look at your bank account and there is now \$1700 in the account. You might even begin to think of the loaves and fish, the small amount, that feed 5,000 men plus women and children or the mustard seed that grew into something much larger.

Now, I want you to think of another scenario. You go to the doctor because you aren't feeling well. The doctor orders some tests. You need to have them, you have health insurance, so you go and have the tests done. Later, you get a bill. Yes, insurance paid some, but you have to pay the deductible or you are in what is called the "donut hole" and you have to pay much more than you thought. You can't pay it all. You try, but there is no way. It's too much. Your debt becomes bigger and then one day debt collectors start calling you. They threaten, they send emails, make calls and leave messages day and night. You have a spiraling amount of medical debt which might have only started as a couple hundred dollars.

Now, what would you say if I told you that for every dollar (\$1) you donate, it would eliminate \$1700 worth of medical debt of someone living in our area. Unbelievable, right? Except it is true. We can eliminate someone's medical debt for pennies on the dollar. It's the reverse of the above scenario.

On Sunday, October 19th we are doing a one-time special offering to help eliminate Undue Medical Debt. The goal for Pittsburgh Presbytery is to raise \$65,000 which will eliminate \$11 million dollars of medical debt. \$11 million - can you imagine. They are asking that we do \$5 per person, meaning about \$1250 from this congregation. We are a generous people - I think we can do more than \$1250. Don't you?

Here is how to donate:

Make a check payable to the church and earmark it as Undue Medical Debt Put cash in an envelope - write your name on the envelope and mark it as Undue Medical Debt Stop by the church office and make a donation Donate online, designate mission, and in the notes write Undue Medical Debt

Together, we can make a real difference in someone's life.
