### Reading from the Psalms

Psalm 141:1-5, 8-10

Leader: O Lord, I call to you; come to me quickly; hear my voice when I cry to you.

People: **Let my prayer be set forth in your sight as incense, the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.**

Leader: Set a watch before my mouth, O Lord, and guard the door of my lips: let not my heart incline to any evil thing.

People: **Let me not be occupied in wickedness with evildoers, nor eat of their choice foods.**

Leader: Let the righteous smite me in friendly rebuke; let not the oil of the unrighteous anoint my head; for my prayer is continually against their wicked deeds. But my eyes are turned to you, Lord God, in you I take refuge; do not strip me of my life. Protect me from the snare which they have laid for me and from the traps of the evildoers.

People: **Let the wicked fall into their own nets, while I myself escape.**
